



Q1 What year did you graduate from the RSPH?








Q9 What degree are you seeking?








Q15 Which category best describes your job duties? (Check all that apply)



Q17 Does your current employer hire doctoral trained employees?





Q18 Does your current employer hire Rollins students (i.e. part-time, REAL, internships, applied practice experience (previously called practicum) positions)?









Q23 Based on your career interests and goals, how valuable is/was your RSPH MPH or MSPH degree in the job market?




