

Q9 What degree are you seeking?



Q12 How long have you been employed at your current job?






Q15 Which category best describes your job duties? (Check all that apply)





Q16 What skills prepared you for the job you currently have? (Check all that apply)





Q17 Does your current employer hire doctoral trained employees?










