As the Spring term begins, here are a few quick reminders of resources to assist instructors with creating inclusive learning environments:

- Respect student identity, pronouns and names.
- Communicate clear grading expectations.
- Incorporate different types of learning activities and a range assessment.
- Review Emory's <u>religious accommodations</u> <u>policy</u> and the <u>2023 religious calendar</u>.
- Address microaggressions that may arise during class discussions or group work (FCDS slides, Sue et al., 2019).
- Be familiar with the <u>Recognize-Relate-Refer</u> <u>model</u> to assist students who may experience mental health challenges and utilize the <u>Student Support Toolkit</u> as needed.

CANVAS TOOLS By ES Team

How can I track student activity in my Canvas Course Site? There are a couple of built-in Canvas tools for instructors interested in checking for students who are not engaged in Canvas.

- <u>Course Access Report</u> Allows instructors to view a summary of a student's participation in their course.
- New Analytics allows instructors to view student participation, grade distribution and comparison across course, section, or student for a weekly aggregate period, and download that data as a CSV file.
