RSPH Graduation: Guest Ticket Redistribution Instructions

Based on the number of confirmed graduate participants and venue capacity limitations, all graduates are permitted **one additional guest ticket** for the ceremony.

On Monday, April 15, 2024, our team will announce how graduates may claim additional guest tickets, should there still be guest tickets available for the RSPH Degree Candidate Recognition Ceremony.

As a reminder, sales of graduation tickets are not permitted. Sales of graduation tickets will be grounds for review under the RSPH Honor and Conduct Code.

Please follow the instructions below for how to claim your additional guest ticket:

- Please <u>log in to the MarchingOrder System</u> using your e-mail and password that you created to initially register for the ceremony.
 - Click "Register Here" to be directed back to your Commencement Registration Form.
 - Under "Your Tickets," select the number of tickets that you would like to claim. You will be able to claim one additional ticket.
 - For example, if you initially claimed 3 tickets when you registered for the ceremony before March 18, you will be permitted to claim a total of 4 tickets.
 - You will be instructed to update the names of all attendees. Please be sure to update accessibility needs and information, if needed.
 - o **IMPORTANT:** Scroll down to the bottom and submit your form.

- NOTE: You have until Thursday, April 11 at 11:55PM to upload your photo for the Personalized Ceremony Slide.
- After you submit your form, the **Print/Email Tickets** button will appear on your Home Page. Here, you will be able to manage your guest tickets and send them to guest e-mails until the day of the ceremony.
- Graduates will receive their ticket, known as a GradPass, closer to the date of the ceremony.
