What are the health and safety requirements that I should complete for New Student Orientation?	Please note that all incoming students must complete the following health and safety requirements <u>prior to their first registered session</u> at New Student Orientation:
	 All students are required to comply with Emory's student immunization policy, including the COVID-19 vaccination. Students must upload their vaccination (and all immunizations) via their Patient Portal by Sunday, August 15 at 11:59PM EST. All vaccinations, including the COVID-19 vaccine, are offered through Student Health Services. Any student who is not fully vaccinated is required to conduct weekly screening testing.

Where is New Student Orientation Check- In?	New Student Orientation Check-In will take place in the Claudia Nance Rollins Building, Plaza Level from Monday, August 16 - Thursday, August 19. When you check in, you will receive your EmoryCard. All students are required to check-in prior to their first required session on their schedule (e.g. Department Meeting, Career Development Training, or Interdepartmental Orientation Group)
What should I bring to New Student Orientation?	Students should bring the following items to New Student Orientation:
What is the recommended attire for New Student Orientation?	We recommend dressing comfortably and wearing flat, comfortable shoes throughout New Student Orientation.
